Side 2: Diphthongs and R-Controlled Vowels

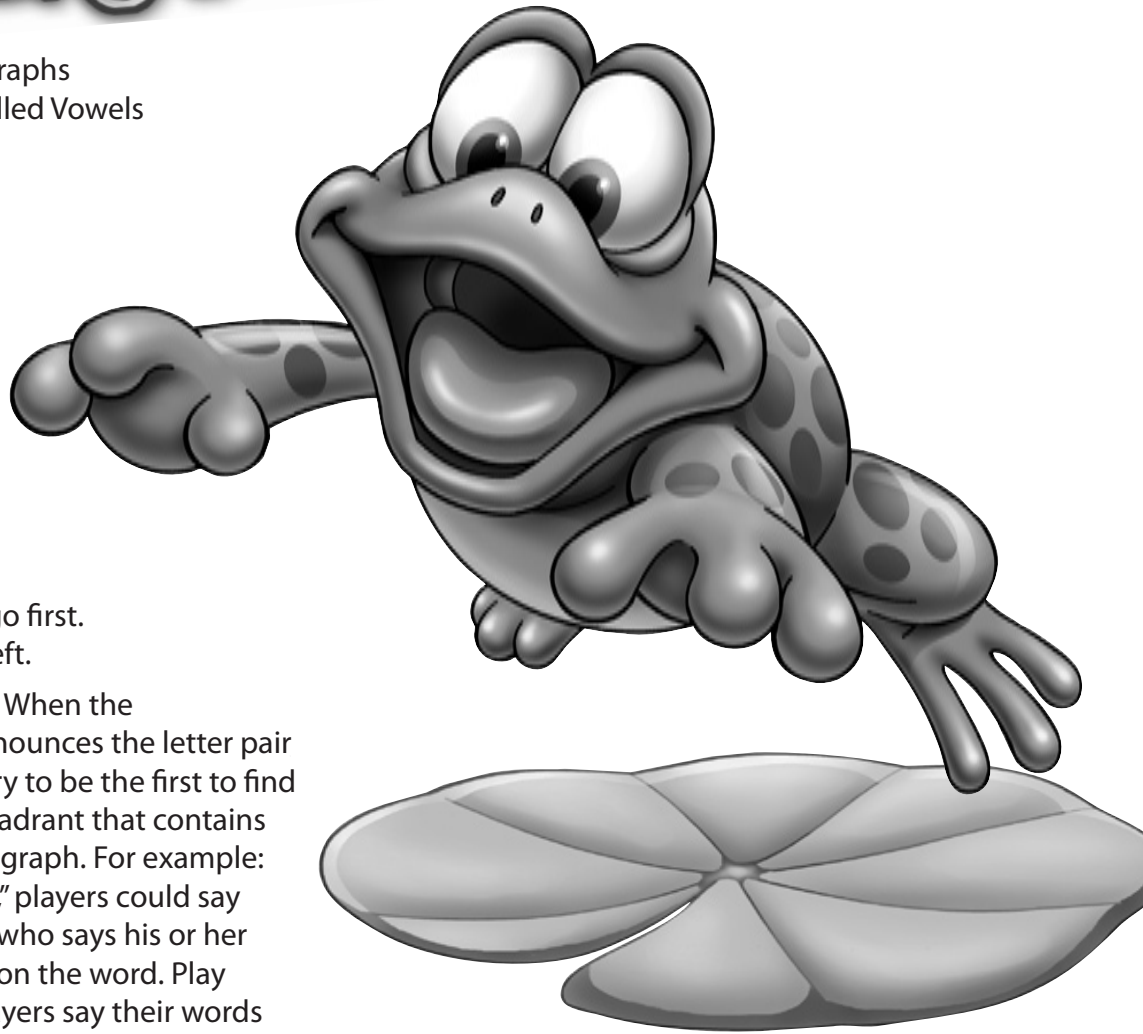
- 2-Sided Game Board
- 2 Phonics Spinners
- 16 Colorful Froggy Markers

**Directions—Side 1**

1. Each player chooses a quadrant in which to play and picks four froggy markers of the same color.
2. Decide which player will go first. Play will continue to the left.
3. Player 1 spins the spinner. When the spinner stops, Player 1 announces the letter pair it has landed on. Players try to be the first to find and say a word in their quadrant that contains the consonant or vowel digraph. For example: If the spinner stops on “ea,” players could say “eat” or “meat.” The player who says his or her word first places a froggy on the word. Play continues to the left. If players say their words at the same time, it is a tie and no one places a froggy. The spinner is spun by the same player again for a retry.
4. The first player to place all four of his or her froggies on the board wins!

**Directions—Side 2**

1. Each player chooses a quadrant in which to play and picks four froggy markers of the same color.
2. Decide which player will go first. Play will continue to the left.
3. Player 1 spins the spinner. When the spinner stops, Player 1 announces the letter pair it has landed on. Players try to be the first to find and say a word in their quadrant that contains the diphthong or r-controlled vowel. For example: If the spinner stops on “oy,” players could say “boy”



or “toy.” The player who says his or her word first places a froggy on the word. Play continues to the left. If players say their words at the same time, it is a tie and no one places a froggy. The spinner is spun by the same player again for a retry.

4. The first player to place all four of his or her froggies on the board wins!

**Alternate Play**

All players may use the entire game board to search for words instead of using only one quadrant. Play continues as before.
