## CHAMPIONSHIP SOCCER

### For the Teacher

#### Object of the Game

To be the first player to answer Story Cards correctly and reach the Finish.

#### Materials

- Game Board
- 96 Story Cards
- 6 Pawns
- Answer Key
- 1 Die
- Directions

#### Number of Players

For 2–6 players.

#### Grade Level

The game has been written on three reading levels:

- Red Level Edition (LRN502): RL 2.0–3.5
- Blue Level Edition (LRN501): RL 3.5–5.0
- Green Level Edition (LRN500): RL 5.0–6.5

#### Story Cards

Story Cards feature leveled passages and ask players to answer questions asking where, who, when, and what happened in the passage.

### Rules of the Game

1. Each player selects a pawn and places it on the Start Space. Shuffle the Story Cards and place them on their spot on the board. Decide whether players will answer the first or second question on the Story Cards when they are chosen. Players can also choose to answer both questions on the Story Card.
2. Take turns rolling the die. The player with the highest number goes first. The player to the left of that person will check the Answer Key. Play continues to the left and the Answer Key passes to the player on the left with each turn.
3. The first player rolls and moves the number of spaces shown on the die. Players can choose to take either the red or the yellow path toward the goals at opposite ends of the board. If a player lands on a Soccer Ball Space, he or she picks a Story Card. The player reads the card out loud and tells the player with the Answer Key his or her answer.
  - If the player is correct, he or she moves ahead one space.
  - If the player is incorrect, he or she remains in the same spot until his or her next turn and play passes to the left.
4. Once the player has reached the Finish Space (Finish does not need to be reached on an exact roll), the player must answer a final Story Card. If the player answers correctly, he or she wins! If the player answers incorrectly, play continues as before and the player remains on the Finish to answer a Story Card on his or her next turn.

### Optional Rules

1. Players may choose to read Story Cards to themselves.
2. One person may be in charge of the Answer Key throughout the game. The person to the player's left checks the answer when it is that player's turn.
