Choose a woman from history and create a postcard that she might have sent.

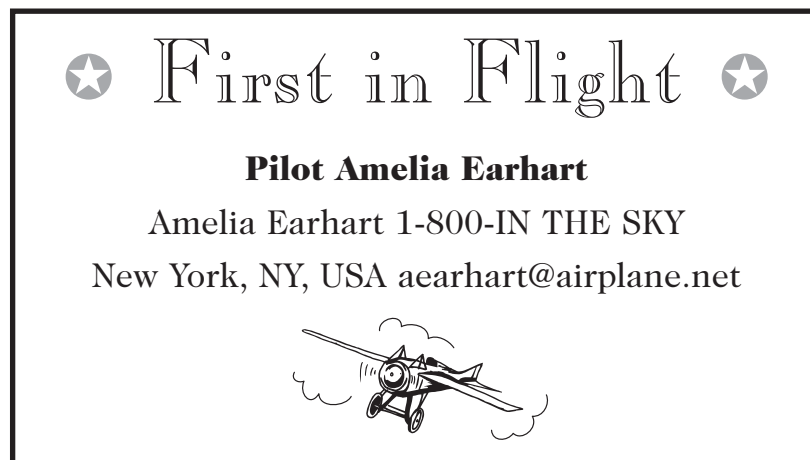
Directions:
