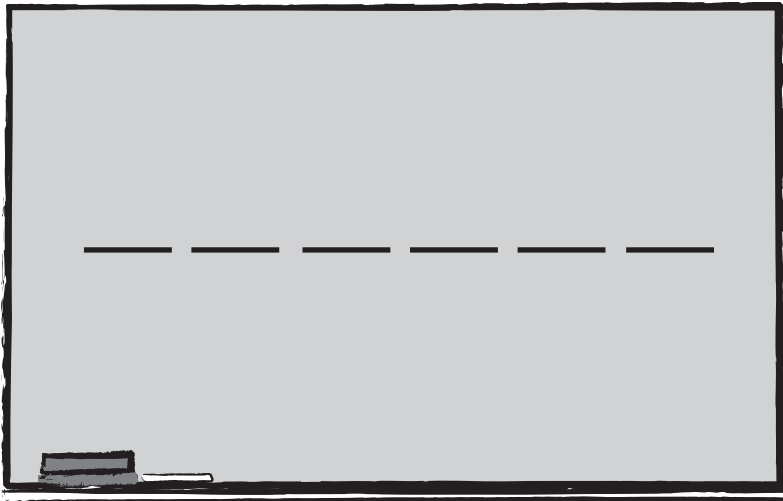


A Jane Yolen Quiz


