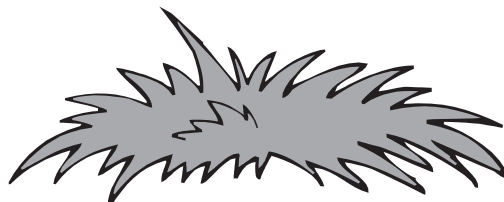
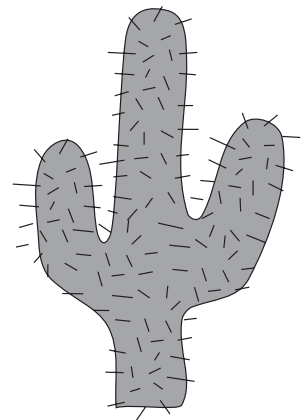
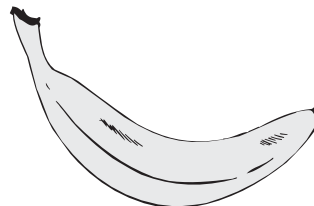
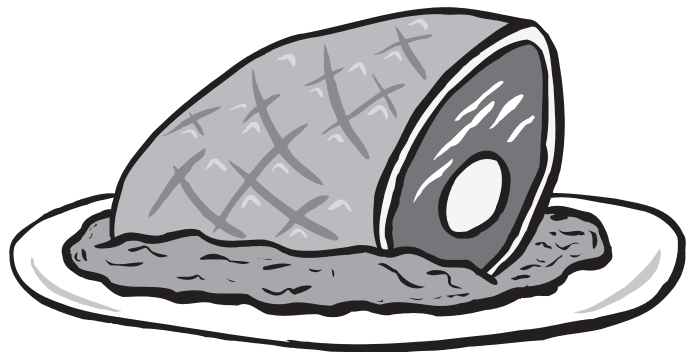
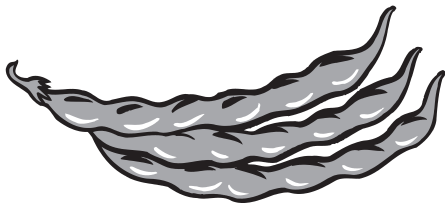
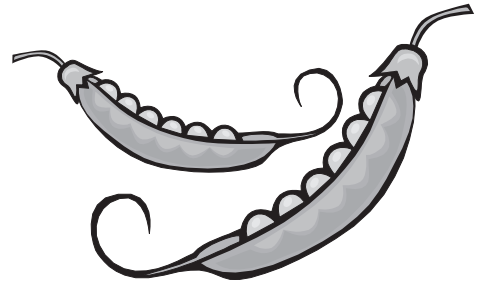
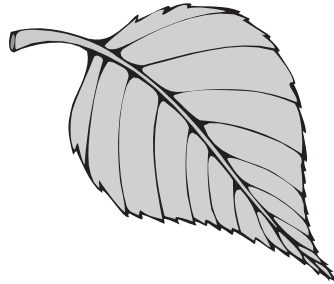
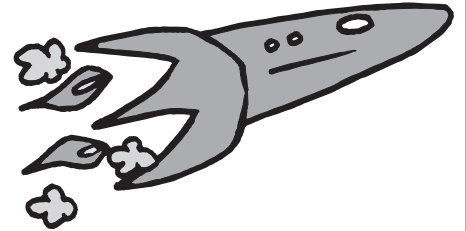
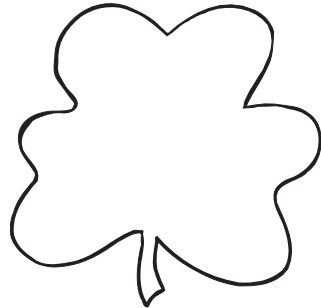
Create your own limerick on the lines below. A limerick is generally a funny nonsense poem with five lines where:

- lines 3 and 4 rhyme

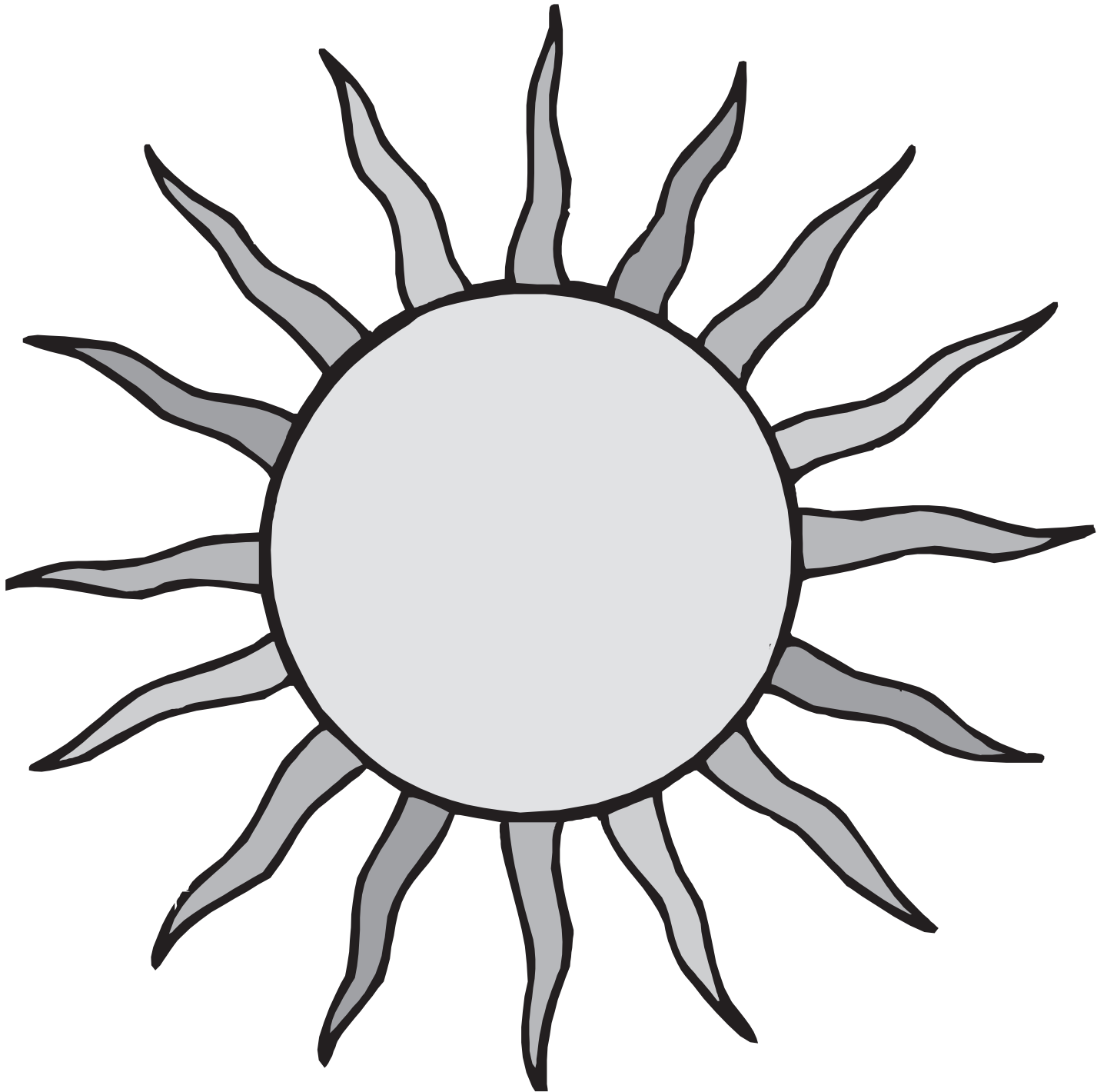
A common limerick goes like this:
